The Assessment Standards Institute (ASI) is pleased to inform you that the formal evaluation of the Emotional Intelligence Assessment (EI) has been completed. Based on the data submitted and the analyses conducted, the EI assessment has successfully met the applicable ASI standards for both Data Reliability and Construct Validity and has therefore been awarded ASI Certification.

The evaluation was conducted in accordance with generally accepted psychometric and professional testing standards, including principles outlined within the Standards for Educational and Psychological Testing developed by the American Educational Research Association (AERA), the American Psychological Association (APA), and the National Council on Measurement in Education (NCME).

The ASI evaluation process included an extensive technical review of the assessment data and measurement structure, including:

The submitted data demonstrated that the EI possesses statistically appropriate construct relationships consistent with a theoretically sound multi-dimensional emotional intelligence framework. The inter-scale correlations supported the existence of a coherent higher-order Emotional Intelligence construct while simultaneously demonstrating

sufficient empirical distinction between the four primary dimensions measured by the instrument.

In addition, the overall quality and integrity of the submitted data met ASI standards for psychometric evaluation, including sample size adequacy, data cleanliness, consistency of measurement, and appropriate statistical behavior across the assessment dimensions.

Based on these findings, ASI has determined that the Emotional Intelligence Assessment (EI) meets acceptable standards for professional assessment evaluation and is hereby designated as ASI Certified.

Your assessment certification is valid for a period of five (5) years from the certification date, subject to no material changes being made to the assessment instrument, scoring methodology, or underlying construct architecture during that time.
